

MONACO COLLECTIF HAÏTI

In response to the violent earthquake which hit Haïti on Tuesday 12 January, and following the will of H.S.H. Prince Albert II, many Monegasque NGO's together with the Office of International Cooperation as well as private companies got united in order to support a joint project: MONACO COLLECTIF HAÏTI.

After several field missions in Haïti, the Collectif chose to support Doctor William PAPE's project: the construction of a nursery school and primary school in Port-au-Prince, managed by Gheskio health centres. Prince Albert II school opened in 2012 and was inaugurated by H.S.H. Prince Albert II on 15th February 2013. 300 children are currently provided education in the school, and also benefit from a personalized follow-up care as the school is integrated in a health centre.
